



I would like to draw your attention to communion we share. The renewal of the liturgy from the Second Vatican Council reminds us that Christ is present in four particular ways in the celebration of the Eucharist; the bread and wine, the priest, the word of God, and the people gathered.

It is a challenge of our times to recognize this holy presence of Christ in the community. Maybe it is because we are sinners, so how could the real presence of Christ be in the midst of us who are imperfect in living out our faith. We also live in a society that greatly emphasizes the individual over the community, so our relation with the risen Christ is focused on our personal devotion and experiences.

The restoration of the Liturgy from the Vatican Council looked back on the practices of the early Christians in how they celebrated the Eucharist. One of the particular aspect of the early Church was the community. It was important how they lived out their faith and lives in communion with one another. In chapter 2 of the Acts of the Apostles how the disciples lived in common, were instructed by the teaching of the Apostles and broke the bread. It seems that there was a profound sense of connection among the disciples.

The experience of communion/connection for our celebration of the Eucharist begins as we enter the Church. The ministry of hospitality is the ministry of the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. Our sisters and brothers who show up early for each of the Masses are engaged in ministering to everyone who enters the sanctuary with the beginning of the real presence of Christ. It can be easy to minimize the importance of this ministry. What they are doing is opening us up to the awareness of Christ in the celebration of the Eucharist.

In the past, we emphasized the need for silence before Mass began so that people could center themselves for the celebration of the Eucharist. Meeting people and saying hello was a distraction. Yet, it is so important that we do greet each other because we are beginning with the presence of Christ in the Eucharist. We are about to enter into a communal prayer and praise in what our God has done for us as a people, not just for each of us as individuals. Eucharist is what we do together. It is like going to dinner and not talking to the people you are sharing the meal with.

I know that some people prefer to kneel when they receive the Body of Christ. Maybe it is a feeling that they are being more respectful to the Lord. Our receiving communion is the community receiving the Body of Christ together. The bishops have asked us to stand as both a sign of our resurrection in Christ and as our communion with one another. The bishops desire is that we continue our real presence of Christ in the Eucharist by having the same posture with one another. It is also calling our attention to the presence of Christ in the community.

As we leave the Church to take up our living of the faith in our daily lives, we also continue the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist by lingering after Mass to catch up with one another. We are remembering that whenever we see each other outside of Mass, like at the grocery store or in our neighborhood we are again in communion with the real presence of Christ, we shared in the celebration of the Eucharist.

The Eucharistic Revival the Bishops of the United States have invited us to participate in is much more comprehensive than just acknowledging that in the bread and wine consecrated at Mass is the real presence of Christ, risen from the dead and eternally present to all the world. I invite you to revive your awareness in the real presence of Christ in the connection we share with one another.

PRAYER OF THE WEEK

O God, who in this wonderful Sacrament have left us a memorial of your Passion. grant us, we pray, so to revere the sacred mysteries of your Body and Blood that we may always experience in ourselves the fruits of your redemption. Who live and reign with God the Father in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever. AMEN
