Not long after my brother's first child was born, a beautiful little girl named Mary Elise, I asked him what it was like. Was he nervous? Overwhelmed? He said, "When I first held her, I was in such shock. I think I just said, 'I am your dad. I am your dad.'" That moment marked a deep transformation for him. He was not just holding a baby; he was stepping into a new identity. Over the years, I have seen him live his fatherhood with quiet sacrifice, joy, and faithfulness. It started with that moment of truth.

This, I propose, is a glimpse of what Jesus means when he prays, "Consecrate them in the truth." (John 17:17) To be consecrated is to be set apart in love, not taken out of the world. Consecration sends us into it with a new identity, always one that binds us to him and to others in love. Our bond to Jesus and others is the deep truth that he continually renews.

Whenever we speak deep truths about ourselves, we experience this renewal: "I have sinned;" "I need help;" "I forgive you;" "I take you as my husband;" "I believe in one God..." Whether in confession, in the liturgy, or in a recovery group, truth heals and transforms.

And the deepest truth of all? That we belong to the Risen and Ascended Christ. Our lives are no longer just ours. We are his and he is ours.

Name one truth you need to step into more deeply, about yourself, someone else, or God. Maybe put it on a note on your mirror. Let that truth consecrate you this week.

Jesús ora por el nuevo pueblo de Dios y encomienda al Padre a sus hijos, que se quedarán en el mundo. Nos dice que la vida eterna consiste en conocer al Padre, único Dios verdadero, y en reconocer que Jesús viene de Él. Estas verdades nos ayudan a seguir adelante en medio de las tribulaciones. El sufrimiento existe en el mundo y nunca desaparece, pero está unido a la esperanza de llegar a resucitar como Jesús; alienta el corazón y fortalece la oración: "El mensaje que recibí se lo he entregado, y ellos lo han recibido y reconocen de verdad que yo he salido de ti, y creen que tú me has enviado" (Juan 17:8). Sin duda alguna, el mensaje de Jesús es que experimentemos la vida eterna desde aquí, en la tierra. San Carlo Acutis decía: "La Eucaristía es mi autopista hacia el cielo". "Cuanto más recibimos la Eucaristía, más nos haremos semejantes a Jesús, de modo que en la tierra tendremos un anticipo del cielo". ¿Qué piensas tú de esta oración de Jesús a su Padre?

"Jesús reza, pide para que la tristeza y el aislamiento no nos ganen el corazón. Nosotros queremos hacer lo mismo: queremos unirnos a la oración de Jesús, a sus palabras, para decir juntos: 'Padre santo, cuídalos con el poder de tu nombre... para que estén completamente unidos, como tú y yo', y que 'su gozo sea completo'. Jesús reza y nos invita a rezar, porque sabe que hay cosas que solo podemos recibir como don; hay cosas que solo podemos vivir como regalo". (Papa Francisco, 20 de septiembre de 2015) Señor, ayúdame a experimentar tu presencia en mi corazón.

Không lâu sau khi con đầu lòng của anh trai tôi chào đời, một bé gái xinh xắn tên Mary Elise, tôi hỏi anh cảm thấy thế nào. Anh có lo không, có choáng ngợp không? Anh chỉ nhẹ nhàng kể: "Lúc bế con bé lần đầu, anh sững lại... rồi chỉ biết nói: 'Ba đây... ba là ba của con đây.'" Khoảnh khắc ấy không chỉ là niềm xúc động, mà là một bước ngoặt. Anh không chỉ đang bế một đứa trẻ, mà đang bước vào một căn tính hoàn toàn mới. Và qua năm tháng, anh sống ơn gọi làm ba với những hy sinh âm thầm, niềm vui giản dị và sự trung tín bền bỉ. Tất cả bắt đầu từ một giây phút chạm đến sự thật.

Điều đó giúp ta hiểu sâu hơn lời Chúa Giêsu cầu nguyện, "Xin thánh hiến họ trong sự thật." (Gioan 17,17) Được "thánh hiến" không phải là tách mình khỏi thế gian, nhưng là được biến đổi từ bên trong, được đặt để trong tình yêu của Thiên Chúa. Chính sự thánh hiến ấy lại sai ta đi vào giữa đời, nhưng với một căn tính mới, căn tính của người thuộc về Chúa, gắn bó với Ngài và với nhau trong tình yêu.

Sự thật ấy không phải là điều xa vời. Nó hiện diện mỗi khi ta dám sống thật với lòng mình, "Tôi đã sai lỗi." "Tôi cần được giúp đỡ." "Tôi tha thứ cho bạn." "Tôi tin kính một Thiên Chúa..." Dù trong bí tích Hòa Giải, trong phụng vụ hay trong những giây phút chân thành của đời sống, chính sự thật có sức chữa lành và đổi mới con người.

Và sự thật sâu xa nhất là, chúng ta thuộc về Đức Kitô Phục Sinh và Thăng Thiên. Cuộc đời chúng ta không còn chỉ là của riêng mình. Chúng ta là của Ngài, và Ngài là của chúng ta.

Tuần này, hãy thử dừng lại và gọi tên một sự thật mà bạn cần bước vào sâu hơn, về chính mình, về một người nào đó, hay về Thiên Chúa. Có thể viết ra, đặt ở nơi dễ thấy. Và mỗi ngày, để sự thật ấy dần biến đổi và thánh hiến bạn.


